DESCRIPTION OF NATURE, PURPOSE, AND BENEFICIARIES OF PROJECT:
 The proposed project is located at Receiving Station F (RS-F) in the Boyle Heights neighborhood of the City of Los Angeles. The proposed project includes removing and upgrading the existing fencing at RS-F. The project will remove and install approximately 2,166 linear feet of new fence, using Amiguard 7100 series mesh. Additionally, the project will replace in-kind two 20 foot motorized gates, one 16 foot double swing gate, one 20 foot double swing gate, and one 8 foot double swing gate. The fence and all gates would be grounded. The anticipated construction start date is June 21, 2021.

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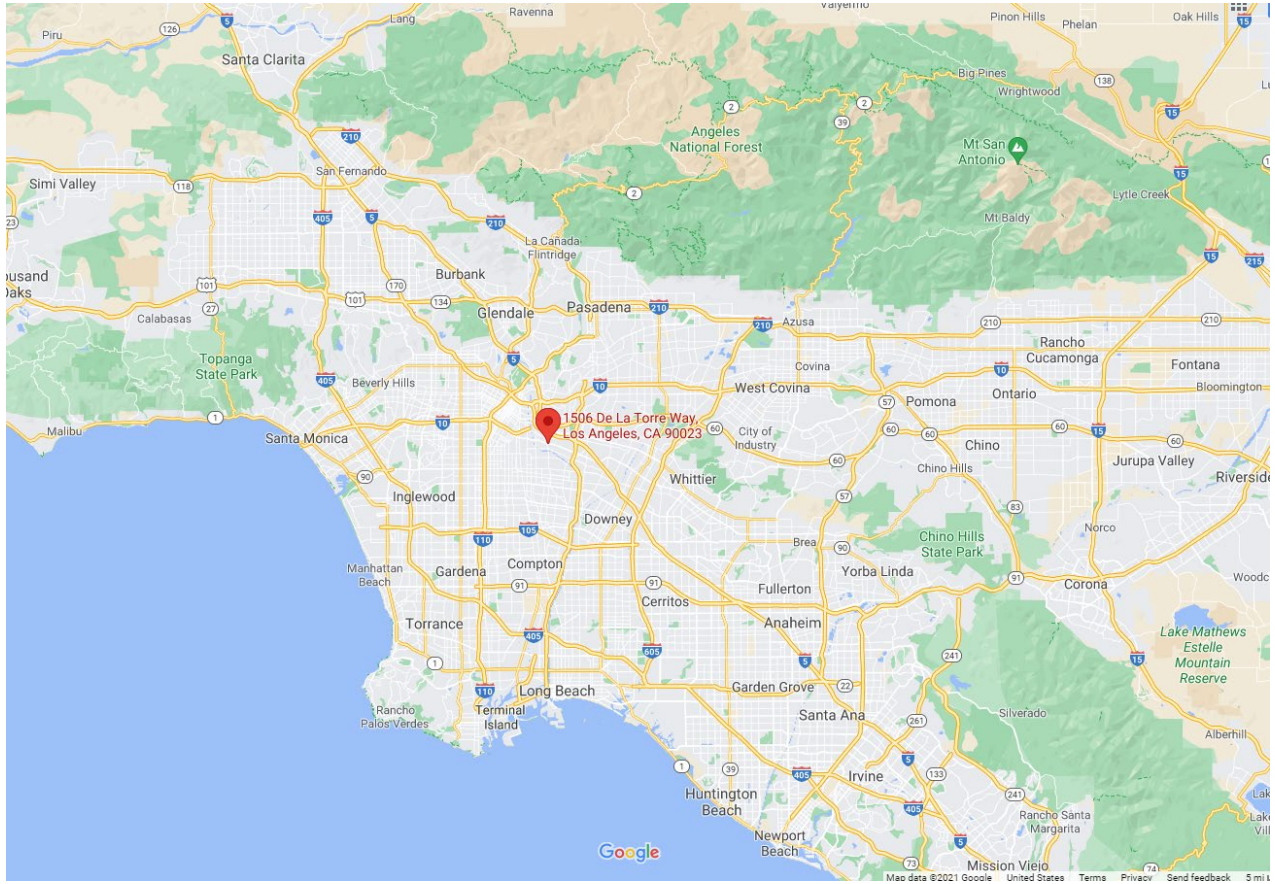
EXEMPT STATUS:
Section 15301, Class 1 (Existing Facilities); Section 15302, Class 2 (Replacement or Reconstruction)

JUSTIFICATION FOR PROJECT EXEMPTION:
 In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act, this project is Categorically Exempt from CEQA review pursuant to section 15301 (Existing Facilities) and 15302 (Replacement or Reconstruction). Section 15301, Class 1 consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of the existing or former use. Section 15302, Class 2 consists of replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced, including the replacement or reconstruction of existing utility systems/facilities involving negligible or no expansion of capacity. The proposal for the perimeter fence upgrades at RS-F meets the requirements of these exemptions; therefore, no further CEQA review is required.
