PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND LOCATION: The City of Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) is proposing to replace the existing Redmont Pump Station, located in the community of Sunland of the City of Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, California, with a new pump station, also located in the community of Sunland. The existing Redmont Pump Station is located at 10503 Redmont Avenue in the community of Sunland of the City of Los Angeles. The site includes the pump station itself, as well as the existing Redmont Reservoir, an underground, covered reservoir which pumps water to the Highway Highland and Apperson Tanks, located approximately 3.5 miles southeast and 2.0 miles east of site, respectively. The proposed replacement pump station site is located at 10709 North Tujunga Canyon Boulevard, approximately 1,500 linear feet northwest of the existing pump station site. Two underground water pipelines, approximately 1,500 linear feet in length each, would be placed in a shared Right-of-Way (ROW) along North Tujunga Canyon Boulevard to connect the proposed replacement station to the existing Redmont Reservoir's water distribution system. Under the proposed project, the LADWP would: (1) construct and operate a new water pump station to replace the existing Redmont Pump Station; (2) construct and operate two new underground water pipelines; and, (3) remove the existing Redmont Pump Station upon completion of the replacement pump station and its associated pipelines. The existing pump station site is approximately 2,000 square feet in size. The "footprint" of the existing pump station itself is approximately 625 square feet in size, and is approximately 20 feet high. Removal of the existing station would involve multiple activities occurring simultaneously; the primary removal activities would include removal of the station's pumps, piping, electrical and mechanical equipment, and demolition of the station's roof, walls and footings. Removal of the existing station would take an estimated 15 working days to complete. Following removal of the pump station, activities at the site would be limited to periodic inspection and maintenance of the existing Redmont Reservoir by existing LADWP personnel.
