PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND LOCATION: The proposed project would provide for improved reliability of the City's potable (drinking) water supply by substituting reclaimed/recycled water generated by the Tillman Water Reclamation Plant (TWRP) for drinking water currently used for irrigation. The project would consist of the construction of approximately 13,200 linear feet (about 2.5 miles) of 16-inch diameter ductile iron pipeline as well as appurtenant structures in public rights-of-way, such as flow meters, maintenance/access holes, valves, and/or vaults, as necessary for the operation and maintenance of the pipeline. The reclaimed/recycled water pipeline would be located in the Encino and Van Nuys communities of the City of Los Angeles, and consists of two segments as follows: (1) Woodley Segment: Woodley Avenue from the southwest corner of the TWRP southeast to the intersection of Woodley Avenue and Burbank Boulevard; and (2) Burbank Segment: Balboa Golf Course (from the existing recycled water tie-in located approximately 1/2-mile east of the intersection of Balboa and Burbank Boulevard) west to Burbank Boulevard, via existing golf course service roads, then southeasterly/easterly along Burbank Boulevard, and then tie into the Woodley Segment at the intersection of Woodley Avenue and /Burbank Boulevard intersection.
