Form Gen. 156 (6/91) (Appendix D)

The Los Angeles Department of Water and Power proposes to construct a buried 110-million-gallon covered potable water storage reservoir and a 4-megawatt hydroelectric generating facility at the Headworks Spreading Grounds site and remove Silver Lake and Ivanhoe Reservoirs from potable water service.

Additional work for the Proposed Project would include constructing approximately 600 linear feet of 84-inch-diameter, weldedsteel underground pipeline and appurtenant structures (e.g., maintenance access holes, flow meters, valves, and/or vaults) at the Headworks Spreading Grounds site, as well as construction of 4,900 linear feet of 66-inch-diameter, welded-steel underground pipeline, appurtenant structures (e.g., maintenance access holes, flow meters, valves, and/or vaults), and an underground regulator station in and adjacent to the Silver Lake Reservoir Complex site.

The Headworks Spreading Grounds site is located at 6001 West Forest Lawn Drive, Los Angeles; and is bounded by the Los Angeles River, the Golden State Freeway, and Forest Lawn Drive, and is adjacent to Forest Lawn Memorial-Park and Mount Sinai Memorial Park.

The Silver Lake Reservoir Complex is located at 2700 Tesla Avenue in the Silver Lake area of Los Angeles and is bounded by Tesla Avenue on the north, Armstrong Avenue and Silver Lake Boulevard on the east and south, and West Silver Lake Drive on the west.
